The 52nd Nationals Are Coming!

We've had some beautiful sailing weather here in New England over the past two weeks. Doesn't it just make you want to experience sailing the lower west passage of Narragansett Bay in September?

The 52rd Bullseve Nationals will be in Saunderstown, RI September 6-8. You have less than three weeks to get your registrations in before the late fees kick in, so do it now! It will be great racing, but perhaps even more important, a chance to reconnect with your Bullseve friends from around New England and the country. So far we know that boats are coming from Rockport, Marion, and Fishers Island. One sailor is coming from Chicago.

Nationals Chair Al Maybach reports that sailing conditions at Saunderstown Yacht Club have been challenging this year. Tides are running a few inches higher, resulting in stronger current along with variable wind. For some of us, this creates an opportunity to learn something new.

The race area will be between the Jamestown Bridge and the North End of Dutch Harbor. This is an area in which the Saunderstown fleet does not race, so it represents the best choice to create a level playing field. It was recently the location for an Optimist Regatta, where young sailors learned what a difference current makes on getting to the weather mark first - an interesting lesson for them to learn. It also became a challenging sailing area as the outgoing tide was against the wind.

Some have asked if there is any alternative to launching and hauling at the Dutch Harbor Boat Yard and Conanicut Marina. This is the only place to put your boat in the water, as there are no available ramps in the area. Trailers will be stored in Jamestown near Dutch Harbor Boat Yard.

Bullseye Class Association Annual meeting 5/4/13

President George Lucas called the meeting to order at the beautiful Heights Cafe at North Hill in Needham, MA. The Boston skyline was clearly visible in the distance.

The minutes of both the Annual Meeting of April 28 2012 and of Executive Committee Meeting of March 3, 2013 were approved.

Lucas started his reflections by noting the passing of two long time members of the BCA, Emily Wick of Rockport, MA and Frank Shumway of Key largo, FL and Rochester, NY, both great sailors and great contributors to our organization.

Lucas explained that Executive Committee decided on some noteworthy changes that will need to be put into effect: The newsletters will be posted on line, and a password protected online directory of BCA members will be created. He reminded us that the 100th anniversary of the hull design will be celebrated next year at the Fishers Island Nationals. Lucas also said that developing affordable buoyancy bags is still a high priority for him, but finding the appropriate manufacturer has not been easy.
